I want to thank everyone for a great first few weeks of classes! All the dancers are doing so well and I am enjoying teaching each of them. Just a few quick reminders and updates:

Shoes : We are starting to move beyond the basics and it is important that dancers soon start wearing their tap and jazz shoes to class. Jazz shoes allow for a much greater degree of flexibility of the foot than sneakers, and tap is an especially difficult style to learn with out the benefit of hearing and feeling the taps against the floor. Just a reminder that all shoes must be black. If your dancer requires shoes please just let me know via e-mail or phone and I will be happy to bring them with me for them to try.
